Powering Up With Biodiesel

reeFUEL, the distributors of biodiesel, announced today the total success in making electricity from their environmentally friendly fuel.

Mark Roberts, of reeFUEL logistics and transport, explains that 100% biodiesel was used to power a 500 kVA diesel generator powered by a V12 600hp turbo-charged Caterpillar 3412 diesel.

The biodiesel trial was conducted in the PacRim Yard in Enterprise Street Bohle.

Also trialling pure biodiesel was a 230 kVA Komatsu 155, six cylinder turbo-charged diesel generator.

“When the biodiesel entered the fuel system, the boys in the yard went bananas”, says Mark, “They loved it”.

Since running on pure biodiesel, the oil pressure has come down to the optimal level and the black exhaust smoke has changed to clear sweet-smelling gas.

“She’s running on veggie oil now I shouted to the boys and they all cheered”, says Mark Roberts.

The generators are part of a growing fleet of vehicles and plant in Townsville being trialled on 100% biodiesel.

Also trialling 100% biodiesel is Hermit Park Bus Service bus which will be taking 50 lucky school kids for a biodiesel adventure on the Strand on Wednesday morning.

“These trials are a critical part of the official launch of **reeFUEL biodiesel** on Wednesday and Thursday this week” says reeFUEL Marketing Manager, Guy Lane.

“This is going to be a huge event”, he says.
